This year's European Spice Association's General Assembly took place for the first time in Bordeaux. The event gathered participants from all over the world for three days of conferences and social events from 31

May to 2 June. This year's conference focused particularly on the health benefits of

particularly on the health benefits of a variety of spices.

Guest speaker Bharat B. Aggarwal gave a fascinating talk on how new findings will disrupt the global spice industry. Bharat is the world's foremost expert on the therapeutic use of culinary spices and the author

of 'Healing Spices'. He explained how breakthrough scientific research is finding that spices-even more than herbs, fruits, and vegetables-are loaded with antioxidants and other unique health-enhancing compounds. Studies **(f** of dietary patterns around the world confirm that spice-consuming populations have the lowest incidence of such life-threatening illnesses as heart disease, cancer, diabetes, and Alzheimer's.

Sanjay Mariwala, CEO of OmniActive Health Technologies, went on to present on Spices : a journey from flavour and color to preventive health care! Rolling-out our clove programme in Madagascar

As announced in our newsletter of October 2016, 24 producers in the Ambatombary region of Madagascar received in May a total of 2000 cloves ready to be planted with the technical support of CTHT (picture on left). Planters have been trained in good plant maintenance practices (mulching, weeding, periodic clearing, fertilization, etc.). An agreement in principle is established between the CTHT and each producer to ensure the beneficiaries' participation in the protection of the girofliers they planted. This project is part of the Vokatra Mevan'ide Touton program. Later this year, these planters will be allocated cinnamon plants (2nd picture from the top on the right).

Ghana's Emission Reduction Programme is approved for inclusion in the World Bank's Carbon Fund


Ghana's revised Emission Reduction Programme waspresented during the 16th meeting of the Forest Carbon Partnership Facility (FCPF) Meeting in Paris in June.

The Ghanaian delegation which included government officials, Cocobod, Forestry Commission, House of Chiefs, civil society and private sector representatives responded to clarifying questions from Carbon Fund participants over 3 days. On June 22nd the World Bank's FCPF adopted a resolution to include Ghana in the Carbon Fund's portfolio.

This is a great achievement and the result of many years of hard work.

Touton remains committed to supporting going forward, notably by efforts contributing to the ongoing development of a standard for Climate Smart Cocoa.
